SPEAKER MARVEL: Ready?

SENATOR DeCAMP: We don't need roll calls, or anything else. Let's just try a board fly once and see what happens there. Is it okay just to say what the motion is so everybody knows? I made a reconsideration motion on the Koch amendment that failed 23 to something or other. We're now voting...we voted to reconsider. We are now voting on that original Koch amendment.

So we ought to take a look at it a little bit sooner than that and that's this next session. You know, I just can't help but wonder what would happen if we would all do the same thing to our own personal businesses that we're doing to the lid bill. I wonder what my fuel supplier would say if I told him I'm only going to pay a seven percent increase for fuel next year, and my feed man would say if I told him I'm going to pay a seven percent increase on the feed, if the fertilizer dealer were told we're only going to pay a seven percent increase on fertilizer, if the labor people were told seven percent. I've told Howard about this and he said I'll settle for seven percent increase on the
