SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Are we tied up now? Okay, thank you. Mr. Chairman, when I first read the proposed amendment submitted by Senator Schmit in the Journal, my first inclination was to say, no I'm against it, but on giving that second thought, I'm inclined to agree with him. I think we need to look at this about a year from now. Look what's happening? Look what happened to the trucking industry...the truck drivers. What did they get? A thirty percent increase over three years plus other benefits. The railroad workers...these are signs on the horizon of what's going to happen. We don't know what it's going to look like a year from now, and I'm sure it's going to look different to us than it does now. We'll have a year of experience. We can continue by our action then, but let's just tell the people right now what we're going to do, we're going to give this a year's consideration. It will be an experience that we're going to have to consider after this year of experience what we're going to do then. I think Senator Schmit has an idea, and I'm going to support him.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit, do you wish to close on your amendment? Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Schmit amendment to 285. Senator Schmit. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Senator Schmit. Have you all voted? Where is Senator Schmit? I need to know whether he wants a Call of the House or not. Record the vote.
