SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 591 be advanced to E & R Initial. The sum total in this bill is about \$2.5 million including appropriations for the Department of Education, Department of Aeronautics, Mental Health and Mental Retardation Regions, Department of Roads, State Colleges, University of Nebraska, a small amount for the Arts Council and the Technical Community Colleges. I move the bill be advanced. Again I think those of you who at least attended the various information sessions were given breakdown as to each of the dollar amounts included in the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to advance LB 591 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.
