SPEAKER MARVEL: Pardon.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Call is raised. Are we ready for....

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Cullan. Are we prepared, Mr. Clerk, for the vote on the Cullan amendment.

CLERK: Apparently we are.
