SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, Mr. President, Senator Cullan so eloquently said that he has to oppose this bill all the way if the amendment doesn't go. I have to believe he is representing basically the opponents. I have to believe that he was in correct in telling me the straight story when he said, by golly, if the amendment goes, he is going to ride with this pony. I accept the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are discussing the Cullan amendment to the bill. Senator Chambers, do you wish to talk on the Cullan amendment? Okay. Senator Cullan, do you wish to close on your amendment? I am sorry but the House is still under Call.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I am glad that Senator DeCamp has accepted the amendment. I think it makes the bill a reasonable bill and I will support it, and for Senator DeCamp's edification, I have not talked to any of the lobbyists about it. I handed some of them a copy of the amendments and I am not sure anybody is happy with it but I am going to go for the bill now.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If we may have your attention, the Clerk will reread the Cullan amendment.

CLERK: Reread Cullan amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, your light is on but Senator Cullan has closed on his amendment. The vote is on the Cullan amendment to LB 69. All those in favor of the Cullan amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, I move the House go under Call and a roll call vote. That's all right. One more.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is....record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 16 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried and the amendment is adopted. The Clerk will read the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President.
