SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion fails. Clerk, continue with reading LB 65. The Chair would appreciate if you would follow the rules. I don't like to do this any more than you do but you have rules and the rules have to be followed. Continue.

CLERK: (Continued reading LB 65.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All unauthorized personnel must be off the floor during Final Reading. Continue.

CLERK: (Continued reading LB 65.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote. We have one more bill on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1684 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Declare the bill passed with the emergency clause attached. The last bill for this morning is LB 560.

CLERK: (Read LB 560 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Hold it. All legislators will be in their seats on Final Reading. Okay, go ahead.

CLERK: (Continued reading LB 560.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on pages 1684-1685 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting and 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.
