

government and this is the established language and clarification so that the individual school districts are not put to any difficulty in the event that such an audit is made by the federal government. The next part of it deals with the federal funds also directing the Department to use certain federal funds for the cost of...partial cost of LB 403, the special education programs of local school districts, and then there is also language indicating that funds that are currently being used, a match again state and federal for career education program development will not be picked up with general funds in total once the federal funds run out, and there is language directing the Department to develop and submit a proposal to the Legislature next session dealing with the fees for teacher certification. This is one of the areas where the fees are not covering the full cost of the operation and there should be an appropriate division between the fees and general fund money. There's no problem this year, but within another year or so why there will be some difficulty and this is directing the agency to assist in that development. In their instructional television program there is suggestion for a study on the part of the department using video tape cartridges to replace with a supplement instructional television as an economy measure. In the case of the... Section 6 deals with the Board of Pardons instructing them to continue with the records management system that was started some years ago, and this is a completion of a... or a continuation toward a completion of an ongoing program. This language specifically is relative to the Department of Revenue dealing with additional funds that is contained in the bill for the statewide equalization values between counties, and the Department of Agriculture there's a series of sections all of which request the Department to make some review of various fees in a variety of inspections that they do which are not carrying their own weight as far as the fees are concerned and this will cause a review of the appropriate division between fees and general fund for those activities. In the Department of Health Section 9, there's a report required, a progress report of LB 494 that was enacted in 1977 dealing with the placement of health care professionals in the rural communities. This is a report that we annually have requested, and then in the program 621 within the Health Department there is language dealing with the emergency medical service. There are some state funds that are being used as we are taking advantage of federal funds, but this language indicates that once this is completed those general funds money will no longer be requested or be appropriated once the project under way is completed.
