SPEAKER MARVEL: You have two minutes.

SENATOR WARNER: ...the state colleges will not do a central systemwide computer system without prior authorization and appropriation by the Legislature. There's similar language in the same vein for oversight for the University of Nebraska, similar language for monitoring of role and mission. The Agricultural Products Utilization Committee are directed in Page 34 to come in with a budget next time that's within their available funds. That's another agency that has been spending more than they are taking in. There is a variety of language covering the Commission of the Aging. The prime purpose of all of those paragraphs deals with as any of those federal funds run out that they should not come back and request general funds to replace those. There's language dealing with the Nebraska Commission of Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice, again repeating language we've had for a number of years that the state will not without legislative action participate in the juvenile justice delinquency prevention Act. There's language covering the Drug Commission again spelling out how their federal funds might be used, and they are to be used for drug programs as opposed to greater administrative people. There's a directive to the Department of Personnel to review some of their programs and report back to us next session to give us some additional information on the character...not character, characteristics of some of the state employees. Finally, the language for the State Claims Board directing how they will keep track of Workmans Compensation claims so appropriate decisions can be made relative to those claims as to the source of funds that the claims will be paid next time. I skipped a couple, Mr. President, but that's generally a description of the bill. It has an operative date of July 1, sunset date of....July 1 of '79 and a sunset of July 1, 1980. I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of LB 596 to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We're voting on the advancement of 596 to E & R for Review. Record.
