SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Nichol and Senator Chambers, as it is now we have \$214,000 coming out of the general fund. We have \$259,000 coming out of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center, which I won't fuss with. But it behooves me that we're asking again to vote on something where we don't know the fiscal costs, and I'm... help me out, will you? How much is it going to cost?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, may I respond?

SENATOR LEWIS: Certainly, Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Haberman, you are correct. If we would pass the bill in its original form the fiscal note would be \$259,000, but my only purpose in bringing this up at this time is that the committee amendments would reduce that amount to \$114,000, and the reason it does of course because so many more people would not be attending the Center at Grand Island. So I perhaps should not have brought up the fiscal note at this time, but I wanted it to be a part of the committee amendments, Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Is this \$114,000 the general funds?

SENATOR NICHOL: Yes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Alright, thank you, Senator Nichol.

SENATOR LEWIS: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I would just like to remind Senator Haberman that there...I know that he is very concerned about costs and that is always very important, but he who knows the cost of everything sometimes knows the value of nothing and occasionally you have to keep that in mind.
