SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the amendments are adopted. Now there is another amendment to the bill on the desk. So the Clerk....

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh moves to amend the bill on Page 6....(Read Maresh amendment as found on Page 1704 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR MARESH: I move that this amendment be adopted. This is clarifying language. It has to do with the Department of Roads. The fiscal office prefers that this claim be paid out of the highway and cash fund rather than the general fund since the claim relates to the Road Department. Mr. Speaker, I move that this amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are we ready for the adoption of the Maresh amendment? All those in favor of the....is this the only other amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the adoption of the Maresh amendment as explained vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the Maresh amendment to LB 579. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: There is nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 579 be advanced to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. This is the advancement of the bill. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We're voting on the advancement of the bill. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Do you have anything else on the desk?
