SPEAKER MARVEL: Is the motion to advance the bill?

SENATOR DUIS: No, to accept the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Duis, are you through explaining the committee amendments?

SENATOR DUIS: Unless there are questions because the committee amendments merely extend it to comply with the federal regulations as to county employees and so on down the line and I would ask for approval of the committee amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the approval of the committee amendments to LB 391. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the committee amendments to 391. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Senator Duis.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Duis has an amendment to the bill and the amendment is on 1557.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this particular amendment has to do with the extension of the health program for those from 65 to 70 so they will be included in the state health program to cover them during the time of their employment up to the age of 70 years. It is a thing that is necessary and we should do for the state employees.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of the adoption of the Duis amendment to LB 391 vote aye. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: A question of Senator Duis, if he would yield please.

SENATOR DUIS: Yes.
