SENATOR DUIS: Yes. It says here, "No coverages provided for by section 41-1620 to 41-1632 shall be afforded to any employee after he attains the age of seventy." In other words, it goes from sixty-five to seventy so they will be covered.

SENATOR KOCH: Well, I guess now the question comes, I think that the Board of Regents the other day in dealing with this subject allowed that individuals could proceed to teach beyond age sixty-five but they would not receive the benefits. Now would the Board of Regents prevail or does this now say the Board of Regents you shall?

SENATOR DUIS: The Board of Regents are entirely separate unit from this and they are governed....

SENATOR KOCH: We are talking only about state employees under the act.

SENATOR DUIS: This is only state employees, not the employees of the University of Nebraska.

SENATOR KOCH: But the University would be treated differently then on that.

SENATOR DUIS: They have to go by a different regulation from the federal government under this particular section because it has something to do with them with tenured professors so we don't cover them under this.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Duis amendment to LB 391. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Duis' amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I would move the advancement of LB 391 to E & R Initial. I think I have explained the bill, but if there is any questions, if you will please direct them to me or to Senator Hasebroock, I think we can clear up any difficulties which you might have.
