SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have any other explanation, Senator Kelly?

SENATOR KELLY: No, I don't, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return 356 to Select File for a specific amendment which is spelled out on page 1588 of the Journal. Senator Koch, do you want to speak to this motion? Okay.

SENATOR KOCH: Was Senator Kelly closing on his proposed amendment?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, I didn't technically do it so if you have a comment why go ahead and then I will see if he wants to close after that.

SENATOR KOCH: Senator Kelly, is this Senator Beutler's amendment that he had some concern about?

SENATOR KELLY: I didn't hear, Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Is this the concern Senator Beutler had on 356 that you are trying to take care of in your amendment or are you increasing the amount the cities would go to purchase without a bid? Sorry, I wasn't paying much attention to your amendment.

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, what this does is allows cities to purchase up to \$10,000 without sealed bids, without advertising or without engineering estimates.

SENATOR KOCH: Okay, I understand it now. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now, Senator Kelly, do you have any other comments in closing?

SENATOR KELLY: No comments, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the return of 356 to Select File for the specific amendment. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is returned. Senator Kelly.
