SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler and Simon would like to be excused until they return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have anything to read into the record?

CLERK: No, sir, I do not.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The first order of business this afternoon is Select File. Item #8, two hour limit. Appropriation bills. Senator Warner do you want to..Mr. Clerk, why don't you read what you have to read and then I will recognize Senator Warner.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 586 and then I have a series of amendments after that.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We have E & R amendments? Senator Wesely, E & R amendments, 586.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 586.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, those opposed no. Motion carried.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have amemnents offered by the Appropriations Committee. Those amendments are on page 1449 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner. These are committee amendments to 586, right? Senator Warner. They are on page 1449 of the Journal. Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, these are all essentially technical amendments to the bill change of language. The first one merely clarifies the expenditure of personal services to be the total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems which clearly separates personal services from fringe benefits as two separate items, which they are, for the purpose of the calculation of salaries. It makes no change. The second one clearly separates that any employee that receives any remuneration via the suggestion box
