SENATOR CLARK: Everyone will take their seats and record your presence please. Did you want a roll call vote?

SENATOR REUTZEL: Well beings how we are short several members I would like to get them here before we have a roll call. I would take call in's but I would like to get them all here before we do so.

SENATOR CLARK: They are not all here yet. Lewis, Haberman, Newell, Newell is here. Senator Maresh, would you record in please. Senator Schmit, will you record in please. We have all but one in now. The Clerk will accept roll call votes, call in votes, pardon me. We are under Call, Senator Simon.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. President, I would ask for a roll call vote.

SENATOR CLARK: Roll call vote has been asked for. We will start the roll when everyone is in their seats. Start the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 19 ayes, 21 nays, 3 present and not voting, and 6 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1742 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost, amendment is not adopted. The Call is raised. Another amendment to the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell moves to amend the bill. That is the amendment found on page 1385 of the Journal.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, this amendment strikes from the cash funds, for the State Board of Public Accountancy \$28,000 for an executive director. The purpose for this is simply this. That the State Board of Accountancy is asking to increase their budget substantially they are going from one employee to three employees in one year. I don't think that they can justify that. They have two positions that they are increasing this year. One is the executive director and the other is an individual who will run continuing education programs. I think that if there is a need for this sort of a program that it ought to be shown before they ask for the additional money. They are asking for \$17,000 additional dollars for this person to run continuing education programs. I don't know what that is going to leave the
