LB 586, 588

SENATOR DE CAMP: I get the distinct impression that you are not supporting this amendment. So I will withdraw the amendment.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you, Senator DeCamp.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have any other amendments to the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I move the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to advance 586 to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed say no. I'm sorry, all those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. I'm used to doing it the hard way. The next bill is 588. Are there amendments on the bill?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, there are no E & R amendments to LB 588. However, I have series of amendments. The first is offered by the Appropriations Committee, Mr. President. Those amendments are on page 1402 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Chair recognizes Senator Warner on the committee amendments to LB 588.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move adoption of the amendment. This is the same amendment that we offered on a number of occasions. It is technical adjustment to the bill and does not effect the amount of funds appropriated and again it just changes the language from personal expenditures for personal services to total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diem and again that is merely so that the personal services limitation is only directed towards the salaries and not the fringe benefits. Secondly, it is the same language that clearly separates out so that any employee that receives a reward for a suggestion that that is not a part of these salary. The last amendment is there was an error in the original draft and it corrects that error. I move their adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the adoption of the committee amendments found on page 1402 of the Journal. All in favor of the motion to adopt the amendments vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.
