LB 588, 593

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Reutzel's request to withdraw his amendment to LB 588, there is no objection, so ordered.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, do you wish to advance the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, Mr. President, I move that LB 588 be advanced to E & R Engrossing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You heard the motion. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed no. Say aye, opposed no. Motion carries, the bill is advanced. Next, 593.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are no E & R amendments to LB 593. However, I have two Appropriation Committee amendments. The first one, Mr. President, is offered on page 1450.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is a corrective one. It is the one that appears on page 1450 and it inserts two programs. This is the re-affirmation, reappropriation bill inserts two programs that were left out and another place it strikes the word require and inserts required with a "D". This is purely a technical correction. I move their adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the committee amendment to LB 593 as found on page 1450. All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendments are adopted. Now where is the second.....

CLERK: The second amendment, Mr. President, is on page 1695 of the Journal. 1695, Senator.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this amendment makes a correction in the bill that was appropriated last time. It is offered because of an Attorney General's opinion, but you will recall that there was \$50,000 appropriated last time which the language specifically said had to be appropriated for what is referred to as the Marina in Omaha. Subsequently there was an Attorney General's opinion questioning the manner in which it was appropriated and what this amendment does is reappropriates that \$50,000 with wording that is
