

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a series of amendments. The Appropriations Committee apparently has three separate committee amendments, Mr. President. The first is on page 1448.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment. The fifth amendment on page 1448 is all technical adjustments there is nothing substantive in it. There are a number of amendments that identify it has number of funds that are appropriated in the back of the bill and it correctly identifies some of those funds that were not correctly identified in the original draft. There are some internal adding errors that were corrected or adjustments made with...none of the effect totals. There is internal reference that was corrected like the other ones, it also has the two amendments like we adopted on the other bill dealing with personal service limitations and the clarification that the suggestion box rewards are outside or above and apart from salaries. On page 75 it strikes an entire section that should not be in this bill but rather should be in LB 585. We will take that up when we to it. This amendment I would move its adoption, as there is no substantive change involved.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendment to 589 as found on page 1448. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the first committee amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. What is the next amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, the second is offered by Senator Warner as Chairman of the Appropriations and that is found on page 1640.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would ask unanimous consent to withdraw that. The same amendment is included in the next one.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Hearing no objection it is so ordered.
