SPEAKER MARVEL: No objection, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Labeledz would like to add her name as co-introducer of the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labeledz asks to have her name added as co-introducer of LB 365. Is there any objection? Hearing none, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment offered by Senator Carsten. That amendment is on page 1497 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me, excuse me just a minute. (gavel) Could we have a little order in the room. It is a little difficult to hear from up here. Repeat it.

CLERK: Senator Carsten would like to add an amendment found on page 1497, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is a technical amendment and really boils down to the very fact that we don't want to permit Omaha to have an added half cent sales tax in addition to what they already have. It is a technical amendment that only says that the tax that is existing on January 1, 1978, it clarifies that it only refers to the half cent that they now have. I move for the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You heard the amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the Carsten amendment as found on page 1497 of the Journal. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays on the adoption of Senator Carsten's motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. What is the next amendment?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.
