SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the DeCamp amendment to the... to LB 398. All those in favor of that motion vote aye. Opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Mr. President, I would ask for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested. The question is shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Senator Landis, Senator Warner, Senator Cope, Senator Keyes, Senator Hefner, Senator Merz, Senator Kremer, Senator Cullan, Senator Haberman, Senator Goodrich, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Newell, Senator Kelly. The Clerk is authorized to take call in votes. Senator DeCamp.

CLERK: Senator Merz changing from no to yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All legislators please take your seats. The House is under Call.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting no. Senator Kahle voting no. Senator Landis voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Is everybody here?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes. There are five excused. Senator Keyes isn't here. Senator Keyes hasn't reported in.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Okay, Keyes is here.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, do you want to record your presence, the House is under Call.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Why don't we have a roll call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Shall we proceed? Call the roll.
