SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested. Clear the Board. All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats, record your presence. Senator Burrows, Senator Landis, Senator Koch, Senator Wesely, Senator Cope, Senator Rumery, Senator Beutler, Senator Johnson, Senator Kremer, Senator Marsh, Senator Hoagland, Senator Pirsch. We are missing Senator Koch, Senator Hoagland. The legislators are to be in their seats. We cannot proceed otherwise. The House is under Call. All legislators please record their presence and return to their original positions. As long as all legislators are in their seats, the Clerk can accept call in votes. The vote is to cease debate.

CLERK: Senator Rumery voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Brennan, do you want to call the roll?

SENATOR BRENNAN: Roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll. The motion is...it is a roll call vote to cease debate. Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me. Will all legislators please take their seats? The Clerk cannot hear the call in votes, the roll call votes. Okay, proceed.
