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in any way statutorily or demand of knowledge of the law to be a Court of Industrial Relations judge or a district judge. They are entirely two different jobs, but with the confusion that we have written into the statutes in this name, it is assumed, just assumed, as Senator DeCamp assumed that the Court of Industrial Relations works like a court and it does not. Support Senator Murphy in his endeavor to allow the public to understand what the Court of Industrial Relations is so that it can properly function as an arbitrary commission in labor disputes for Nebraska employees.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair would appreciate if you would limit your remarks so that there isn't too much repetition. We are going to run out of time, otherwise. Senator Nichol, then Senator Cope.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, I will say twenty seconds worth. We are talking about naming the Court of Industrial Relations a commission. I think it would be good for one reason. I think the word "court" is scary to some of us and I think having it a commission would encourage those who are afraid of courts to use the Court of Industrial Relations. Therefore, I approve of changing the name to commission instead of court.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Mr. President, members, when you vote consider this, what would you think if we had the Court of Power Review instead of the Power Review Board? They do the same thing. What would you consider if we had Court of Public Service instead of Public Service Commission? I can't see a bit of difference so I certainly do believe that this would be a good change and put it exactly what it is, a commission.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp. The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I see five hands. Question is, shall debate cease on this motion? All those in favor vote aye. opposed no. This is to cease debate. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate has ceased. The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy for the purposes of closing on his amendment.
