SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 421 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1773, Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. We are going to read one more bill and I would appreciate your cooperation. The Clerk will read LB 427.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 427 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Voting on LB 427 on Final Reading. These next few bills have only a few pages. I think we will just proceed with them. It will only take a few minutes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1774, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 0 nays, 7 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. The Clerk will read LB 568 on Final Reading.
