SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all recorded your presence? Senator Clark. Senator Clark, would it be possible for you to record your presence? Thank you, sir. We need one more vote so we can start the business for the day. Record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, I think we are ready to start with 587.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 587.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, do you want to move the E & R amendments to...

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to LB 587.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted. Are there any other amendments on it?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I have several. Mr. President, I have Appropriation Committee amendments to the bill, and those are on Page 1448 of the Journal.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendments. The amendments appearing on 1448 again are all technical amendments making no change in the appropriations. They are the same amendments that we have put on each of the bills dealing with the word usage defining the personal services that are contained in the various state agencies in this bill, plus a couple of other word changes where it strikes "for" in a couple of places.
