SENATOR FOWLER: I'd call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Five hands to cease debate. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on ceasing debate on the Murphy amendment to the bill. The motion is to cease debate. Who moved that we cease debate? Senator Fowler, do you want a Call of the House?

SENATOR FOWLER: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to clear the Board, Mr. Clerk? The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please return to their seats, record your presence, and the motion...or the issue before the House is cease debate. Senator Burrows. Senator Warner. Senator Keyes. Senator Schmit. Senator Beutler. Senator Kahle. Senator DeCamp. Senator Haberman. Senator Marsh. Senator Stoney. The motion before the House is whether or not this Legislature shall cease debate on the Murphy amendment to LB 587. If the legislators will please take your seats, we can take call-in votes. The House is under Call. Okay, go ahead.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye. Senator Reutzel voting aye. Senator Goodrich voting aye. Senator Lewis voting aye. Senator DeCamp continues to vote aye. Senator Kahle voting aye. Senator Newell voting aye. Senator Stoney voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate has ceased. The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy to close on his amendment to the budget. Do you want to read the amendment?

SENATOR MURPHY: Fine.
