SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the Newell amendment to LB 587. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed no. Have you all voted? The motion is the Newell amendment. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The amendment's adopted.
