the Legislature is responsible for the University and don't you get out of line, and don't you get out of bounds of where you ought to do it. Mr. Chairman, I urge the adoption of my amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, let's take up the Lamb amendment to the Lewis amendment first, and then we'll take those that want to speak to one or the other of them. Go ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb moves to amend the Lewis amendment on Page 1753 of the Journal. (Read Lamb amendment.)

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, as Senator Lewis explained his amendment would take half of this money, or about 550,000 dollars from Central Administration, and the other half from the East Campus, and so...or from Ag...actually it's from the Agriculture Campus, and since there are a couple of buildings out there which really do not serve agriculture, the law school and the dentistry...the school of dentistry, I'm dividing up this money and charging 300,000 of that 550 to the down...what's ordinarily known as the downtown campus, and so the Ag College would then absorb the rest of it, about 250,000. So instead of Ag Campus absorbing all of that, half of the total one million one hundred thousand, they would be absorbing slightly less than one-fourth. I urge the adoption of the amendment to Senator Lewis' amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. I've got some lights here. Senator Reutzel, do you wish to speak to the...okay, the question's been called for. Do I see five hands? The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor of that motion vote aye. Opposed no. The question is, shall debate cease? Have you all voted? We're voting on whether or not we cease debate. Have you all indicated your preference? Okay. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Debate ceases. The Chair recognizes Senator Lamb to close on his amendment to the Lewis amendment.

SENATOR LAMB: My amendment once more, under Senator Lewis' amendment, half of this one point one million dollars comes from Central Administration, and half from the Ag Campus. My amendment says half from the Central Administration, and
