jeopardize any of those because they might be cut, but he'll jeopardize operating budgets to fund something he feels is important. I do not believe in funding capital construction projects with operating budgets, and I certainly, against my wish, have to support Senator Lewis' amendment to his amendment, for fear the whole thing will pass and I disagree entirely with Senator Newell.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I'm wondering if we could get the Clerk to put us in perspective as to what we're actually doing here. I called up there a little bit ago. Senator Lamb, I hope you listen. I'm wondering if we can get in perspective of what is now the part of the amendment, because I thought I heard you say something about eighteen million dollars, and then something again was said about a million so much and so on down the line. Would it be possible, Mr. President, to get this put in perspective so we know where we are before we do any of the voting?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Can the Chair help you, Senator Duis?

SENATOR DUIS: Well, I don't know, maybe Senator Lamb can help us, but I think now we've gone through about three amendments...an Amendment, and then an amendment to an amendment and now we're going to have another amendment. I hope it's to amendment instead of to an amended amendment. But I would ask if Senator Lamb will tell us just exactly where we are because we're flipping from one page to another. Senator Lamb.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Lamb and then Senator Frank Lewis. Senator Lamb, do you want to answer the question?

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. President, if you'll turn me on I'll answer it very easy. Senator Lamb amended my amendment which was adopted to spread the money out into two or three areas. Senator Newell previously had taken a hundred and twenty-three thousand dollars out of the University budget. I said okay let's use that one hundred and twenty-three thousand and make the shock a little less for Central Administration. They're still losing about four hundred thousand dollars, which I know they can find.
