SENATOR LEWIS: Well, I'm sorry, I was trying to answer the question.

SENATOR DUIS: That's alright. Well, I'm not getting my question answered. What I want is on Page 1753, to tell us what figures are in this amendment that we're working over. Tell us what the figures are. I want them all.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Duis, the first Lewis amendment subtracted \$550,000 from Central Administration. Then now he is...

SENATOR DUIS: How many dollars was that, the original Administration...

SENATOR LAMB: Okay, Central Administration originally was \$1,848,122. Then Senator Lewis' amendment dropped that down to \$1,298,122. Now he wants to add \$123,000 back to that number, which is the amount that Senator Newell subtracted from the SUN program. So he will be, in effect, if his amendment passes now, he will be subtracting about \$427,000 from Central Administration, about \$300,000 from the downtown campus, and about \$250,000 from the Ag Campus...

SENATOR DUIS: Alright, now...

SENATOR LAMB: ...to pay for this \$1,100,000.

SENATOR DUIS: Okay, now tell me what your amendment figures were?

SENATOR LAMB: Well...
