SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, how much time do each of these bills get that we're putting on Special Order?

SPEAKER MARVEL: You mean the 172 and 152, for instance, thirty minutes.

SENATOR KOCH: Thirty minutes?

SPEAKER MARVEL: They go to the bottom of the pile and then we reprocess them, yes sir.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp. I'm sorry, LB 152, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 152.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely. Senator DeCamp. Senator DeCamp, will you move the adoption of E & R amendments to 152?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a series of amendments. The first is offered by Senator DeCamp, and that's on Page 1665.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Which one is that?

CLERK: Insert a new section 11. After January 1, 1980 the offenses of prostitution...

SENATOR DeCAMP: Okay...what...offenses of prostitution...

CLERK: Offenses of prostitution, pandering and keeping a place of prostitution....

SENATOR DeCAMP: No, leave that out.

CLERK: You don't want that one?
