SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Read the next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp now offers an amendment to add a new Section 5. (Read DeCamp amendment as found on Page 1793 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, the issue has been raised about the felony. This puts a felony into the bill, a very serious felony for debt collection, attempted intimidation enforcement. I have been instructed and advised by Paul Douglas to say that if this goes in and the other amendment you just adopted that he strongly supports the bill. He feels the bill is needed, and he hopes the bill will pass. The questions that Bernice raised I think are adequately taken care of. I talked to Mr. Bucchino about this amendment. Mr. Bucchino supports the amendment. Needless to say, Mr. Bucchino would like a lot of other amendments on it. I think in this form the bill is reasonable. I repeat, it puts a felony provision in for attempted debt collection. Mr. Douglas advises me and other people that this is where the difficulties develop in the gambling and so on. So I would urge adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is on the second DeCamp amendment to 152. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, what? Need one vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I now move the bill be advanced. I repeat, Mr. Douglas has said as the bill is structured now he supports it. He wants it. Mr. Bucchino said he wanted that last amendment. I repeat, I don't know what else Mr. Bucchino wants.
