E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? The vote is on advancement of the bill. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I ask for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the House going under Call vote aye, opposed no. Okay, record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the House is under Call. All legislators please return to your seats, record your presence. See that unauthorized personnel leaves the floor. Senator Sieck. Senator Koch. Senator Warner. Senator Keyes. Senator Fowler. Senator Schmit. Senator Beutler. Senator Kremer. Senator Wagner. Senator Simon. Senator....okay. Call of the House is on advancing the bill. The Clerk is authorized to take call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Vickers voting aye. Senator Reutzel voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Brennan voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll. A roll call is requested.

CLERK: (Roll call vote was taken which may be found on Pages 1793 and 1794 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion fails. The bill does not advance. Senator Duis, are you ready to take up the last bill, LB 390? What is the status of the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 390.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes. Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 390.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The amendments are adopted.
