CLERK: (Read record vote which may be found on Page 1795 of the Legislative Journal.) 14 ayes, 21 nays, 14 not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion lost. What do we have before the House?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have is the... Senator Burrows moves to indefinitely postpone the bill, and that will lay the bill over, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the bill is laid over. Senator DeCamp, do you wish to move adjournment until 9:00 tomorrow? Have you got something to read in? Go ahead.

CLERK: Senator Landis asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 444, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is that it?

CLERK: Yes sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I move we adjourn until tomorrow at 9:00.
