CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Murphy's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Does Senator Reutzel have an amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator Reutzel now moves to amend.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, very quickly these are technical amendments to 99 in referring to the retirement to make sure that the Commission does not deal with retirement aspects, only the salary aspects, and the rest of the amendments are technical. I move the adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the Reutzel amendments to LB 99. Senator George, do you have a.... your light is on.

SENATOR GEORGE: Just a question. The rest of them are technical but where are they? Are they in the Journal?

SENATOR REUTZEL: Were they printed in the Journal?

SENATOR GEORGE: Are we adopting all of the amendments just in one vote?

SENATOR REUTZEL: All of the amendments. They're all technical in nature, really.

SENATOR GEORGE: You mean I have to trust you and vote for them. Is it that kind of vote?

SENATOR REUTZEL: You can trust me or you can get a copy of this. I don't care. Either way.

SENATOR GEORGE: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, your light is on. Do you wish to speak to the Reutzel amendment? Your light's on, do you wish to speak to the Reutzel amendment? Okay the motion is the adoption of the Reutzel amendment to LB 99. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on a series of amendments to LB 99. Have you all voted? Record.
