SPEAKER MARVEL: Well as I understood, Senator Haberman withdrew his amendments and supports the Lewis amendment. That is not true? Okay.

SENATOR CLARK: I think Senator Lewis' amendment was to the Haberman amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Lewis now has Section 27 and Section 35 plus some new language. Just a minute...Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk. Are you ready to proceed now? I have got it worked out here.

SENATOR CLARK: Well now, as I understand it...(interruption.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are three subdivisions in the Haberman amendment and there are three subdivisions in the Lewis amendment to the Haberman amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: That is right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do I have that right now?

SENATOR CLARK: That is right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

SENATOR CLARK: As I understand it, what Senator Lewis is doing is taking out the library at Kearney State, the Ag Engineering Building and then adding the chiller. Right? And then Haberman is taking out the Eppley UNO Temple Building and the Historical Building. Is that right?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR CLARK: And what I want to do is divide the question on whatever residual part of this...these two amendments is. It may be six divisions and it may be three.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Chair is ready to proceed. We are talking about LB 594. First of all we will take up the Lewis amendment and then we will take up the Haberman amendment. There are three issues in each amendment. Is the Legislature with us now? Okay, we start with striking Section 27. We are on bill 594, striking Section 27. Senator Lewis, do you wish to speak to that first?

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. President, I think the legitimate way to proceed if you are going to divide the question is the adoption of my amendment and then when you get it all in
