SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the Lewis amendment to the Haberman amendment. All those in favor of the Lewis amendment vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays on adoption of Senator Lewis' amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. The Lewis amendment to the Haberman amendment is adopted. Now would you please read the Haberman amendment? (pause.) Okay, pursuant to Senator Clark's request we will proceed with the six different votes on the Lewis-Haberman amendment. First vote we are referring to first of all LB 594, on page 13, the first vote is to strike Section 27. Is there any further discussion on that particular... There are six parts to this. I am operating under duress but I think we will try it because we have already voted on half of this. Senator Simon, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR SIMON: Just a point, if the Clerk could now read that section, or not only read what section we are striking but the amount and where it is attributed to. That would be appreciated.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are there others who are on their feet to ask the same question? Okay, the Clerk will read Section 27. Is this what you want, Senator Simon? You want to know what is in Section 27 for instance?

SENATOR SIMON: All I need is a dollar amount and where it is going.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Section 27 of the bill reads as follows: Program 923, Kearney State College is authorized to develop preliminary plans for an addition to the Calvin T. Ryan Library with a total project cost of not to exceed \$4,069,500. There is hereby appropriated \$25,000 from the State Building Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980, to develop such plans.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay now, the motion is the adoption of this first amendment which is to strike Section 27. It is still an amendment. Senator Lewis, do you want to be recognized?
