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using the word "thereafter" as they have done, it was to relate to the occasion of the incident so that I have within ten days a chance to recall and establish some kind of a defense. I am asking that that be clarified in this manner and I will give you copies of the transcript of the floor debate, anyone who wishes it. Secondly, we have put the accused person in the position of having to respond to the department within ten days. However, the department has an unlimited time, a hundred and eighty days to file the charge, unknown limits of time to respond to the response that I am required to give within ten days. I drop everything, get my reply into these people and then they sit and look at me. Now this has happened within the last two months and the party agreed, the party who was charged had to call the department and please ask them to continue the thing so that he would know where he was and what he was doing. Now all this amendment says is, whatever time limits are put on this and the department can pick its own time and its own intervals, but if it is to be a ten day exchange, it is to be a ten day exchange both ways. If I must respond in ten days, the department must respond in ten days. If they want twenty days, we both have twenty days. If they want thirty, we both have thirty but to say that I must respond within ten days and then they can take their own sweet time about carrying out the balance of the transaction, again is grossly unfair. We set up standards for one but not for ourselves. So I am asking the adoption of this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the Murphy amendment to the bill. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Well some people play fair and I want to tell you of the very great courtesy which Senator Duis had of telling me he had filed an amendment. I told him I would read my statement, that it would be a nonemotional thing. What the committee had heard, what the committee was familiar with was discussed and it was a fair discussion. I do not feel that Senator Murphy has been very fair. This was not discussed at the public hearing. This has not been brought to my attention before this two minutes ago. I do not feel that this should be slid in at the last minute without a public hearing. I feel that Senator Duis and his courtesy was great. I do feel that this legislative body owes some courtesy to an introducer of a piece of legislation.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: I guess I would ask a question of Senator
