SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please retain or move to your seats, record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Warner, Senator Cope, Senator Koch, Senator Keyes, Senator Merz, Senator Haberman, Senator Wagner, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Frank Lewis, Senator Chambers, Senator Kelly. Jim, we are talking about Senator Koch, Senator Keyes. Senator Keyes, Senator Koch, Senator Lewis. Senator Murphy, do you want to proceed with the roll call? Three absent and four excused. Call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1823 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Motion now... Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Well it is back to its noncontroversial form, thank you. I move for the advancement of LB 80.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, opposed no. All in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Are you ready for the next bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 152, the E & R amendments were adopted by the body yesterday. At that time there was an amendment offered by Senator DeCamp, Beutler and Johnson which was adopted. Senator DeCamp had a second amendment which was adopted. I now have pending an amendment offered by Senator Chambers. That amendment is on page 1634.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, some things have been done to this bill yesterday when I wasn't here so I am going to ask unanimous consent to withdraw that amendment that I have in the Journal.
