CLERK: Roll call continued. Is Senator Keyes voting?

PRESIDENT: Did Senator Keyes vote or not?

CLERK: Senator Warner changing from yes to no.

PRESIDENT: Did Senator Keyes vote or not, I didn't understand.

CLERK: Senator Keyes voted no, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Is that right?

CLERK: Senator Keyes, how are you voting? Senator Keyes changing from no to yes.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. President, I would like to change from yes to no for purpose of reconsideration.

CLERK: Senator Reutzel voting no, changing from yes to no.

PRESIDENT: Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The bill fails on Final Reading. We will proceed then, Mr. Clerk, on Final Reading, since we have all the members present now, with LB 250.

CLERK: Read LB 250 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 250 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read.

PRESIDENT: Senator, you want a roll call vote? All right, we have not announced it. In keeping with what I said of the roll call vote, a member has requested a roll call vote. Proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken.

PRESIDENT: Record the vote.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President. (See page 1836, Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. LB 250 fails on Final Reading.
