LB 331, 395

Before we take up the next bill, the Chair would like to introduce from Senator Simon, Koch and Stoney's Districts, 83 junior-senior students, Government Class at Millard High. They are up here in the North balcony, Richard Brown, Instructor. Would they stand and be recognized? Welcome. And over here on the South side, we have from Senator Murphy's District, 31 eighth grade students from Wakefield High, Joe Coble, Instructor. Would they stand and be recognized and welcome to your Legislature, and just to tell these students that the reason your legislator is not able to come up and be with you or to greet you is that we are on Final Reading, that the rules of the Legislature prescribe that every member will be at his or her desk during Final Reading. Some of you may have come in while we were bringing some of the members back to their desks for the purpose of Final Reading. The Constitution requires that every last word of every bill be read on Final Reading and that is what we are doing here this morning if you are wondering what is going on. So, Mr. Clerk, you will proceed to read on Final Reading LB 331.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 331 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 331 pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1837, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 39 ayes, 5 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 331 passes with the emergency clause attached on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read, just a moment, before we do I would like to introduce from Senator Koch's District 45 fourth grade students from Underwood Hill School, Omaha, Nebraska, Joyce Prohaska, their instructor, up in the South balcony. Would they please stand and be recognized? Good morning and welcome to your Legislature. On Final Reading and you will just be hearing the Clerk read to you this morning. That is what you are watching. So the Clerk will now read to all of us LB 395.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 395 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 395 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.
