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that we take these one at a time without discussion as to whether we should bring it back, without discussion of the merits of the bill, and advance it on that basis?

SPEAKER MARVEL: I think, I am not sure I understand your question, let me explain what I think we should do and then if that doesn't answer your question, then you can come back at me. Let's take LB 16, for instance. The first motion would be the suspension of the rules so the bill can be considered and either vote it up or down. Now if the suspension of the rules does not carry on LB 16, then it is open, like any other bill, it is open for discussion and it is open for amendments. So the Legislature can consider each of these five with suspension of the rules or without. The bills are there. It is up to you to do what you want. If you do not want to do anything, that is perfectly fine. Now does that answer your question?

SENATOR NICHOL: Partially, and thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, I would like to answer it wholly. So could you tell me where I haven't answered the question.

SENATOR NICHOL: The point I was trying to bring out, Senator Marvel, was this, if we open it up for discussion at any point, either to take it up now or if we decide, yes, we will take it up now, then if it is open for discussion, these type of bills are going to go on endlessly in discussion and this is what I object to, Senator Marvel. Now if your suggestion is to take #16, vote on it without discussion as to whether we suspend the rules, vote on it whether or not we advance it without discussion, that is one thing. But if we open it up for discussion, any or all of these bills, open it up for discussion, it is going to take a lot of time which I feel will take away from other bills that perhaps this body thinks are more important than these bills.

SPEAKER MARVEL: May I answer the question now?

PRESIDENT: Yes, respond, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The first point is that there...I would differ from Senator Cullan to this extent that we are constantly treating bills up and down the line in special categories and I would refer to one he is interested in at the moment, and that is going to come up on point #8 and that is Select File, LB 172 is a bill that is a much debated bill. Senator Cullan has interest in that bill. That bill has received special treatment because it
