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has in my opinion, and you put me in this position to express my opinion, in my opinion it has importance enough to receive special consideration. It is almost impossible to set up categories of bills where some bills get less consideration...no, it is impossible to set it up so that all of the bills, whether we are talking about General File, Select File, get equal treatment. We are trying desperately to do that. It is a little difficult to do it but as far as Senator Nichol is concerned the attempt would be made, unless the introducers disagree, to suspend the rules for the purpose of simply considering the bill and either vote it up or down as far as advancement is concerned. If they do not get 30 votes to suspend the rules for that purpose, then the bill is open for debate and open for amendment and I don't know how to prevent it unless the introducer wants to withdraw the bill after the suspension would fail.

SENATOR NICHOL: Thank you, Senator Marvel. This does answer the question and I would only say that if we go into this and start suspending the rules, we are going to open it up for a lot of discussion. I would be opposed to it at this time, so that we can have cooperation among the group and with the Speaker to get to the other bills that are apparently more important. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fitzgerald.

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Mr. Speaker, the question I wanted to know, what are the ground rules and what we was going to do and Senator Marvel has answered my question.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: A question, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: You mean you are asking that we....

SENATOR SCHMIT: I am asking for the question, yes.

PRESIDENT: That we proceed. All right. The question is going to be, we are just going to take these up one by one, follow the Speaker's order unless someone challenges the Speaker's order. That is the only way. In fact I was going to ask, if we are going to have protracted debate, that somebody ought to make a motion to object to the Speaker's order and take care of it that way because otherwise the Speaker has said we are going to take these up one by one. The first vote is to suspend the rules. If you don't suspend the rules, you are going to debate the matter. Senator Marsh.
