PRESIDENT: Motion to recess is always in order if you want to...I will call a motion. All in favor of recessing for fifteen minutes say aye, opposed nay. The nays have it. We are not recessed. We will proceed with agenda item #7 on motions. LB 285 is next up. The Chair will proceed. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Before we proceed, we will have order in here and we will proceed with the item on the agenda. The Chair will read the motion. All right, will the press please return....that is correct. The Clerk is correct. The House is under Call. We will proceed with agenda item #7, LB 285. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, before we can proceed, we have to adopt E & R amendments and readvance the bill and then we can entertain Senator Carsten's motion.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 285.
