All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Senator Simon, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR SIMON: A point of clarification, please. If the vote receives 25 votes, that would merely place 221 back on General File and then it would have to have an affirmative vote to advance to E & R initial. Is that your interpretation? By this vote we cannot move that bill to E & R initial in one vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There has to be a separate vote to advance and I would propose and I will tell you this ahead of time, I am not trying to influence votes but if the vote carries then I would propose before we leave here to set a time for it.

SENATOR SIMON: Thank you, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, all those in favor of the Kelly motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: I would make a Call of the House and ask for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clear the board. The question is, shall the House go under Call. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.
