CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried and the amendment is adopted. Now, will you read the last Murphy amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy moves to amend: Read Murphy amendment (9) on page 1859, Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Ladies and gentlemen, this is simply a point of clarification and it changes nothing I don't believe in the intent. I believe that Senator Koch will more than likely concur in it. It simply says that in distributing the funds to the various subdivisions of the body it will be in the same proportion in which other taxes are being received.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, this is implicit in the section but if it bothers Senator Murphy, if he wants to clarify it additionally, I will accept the amendment in good faith.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the Murphy amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The amendment is adopted. The Clerk will read the next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy moves to amend: Strike beginning with the word "in" on line 15, page 27 through line 3 on page 28.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, is this counting against my time now?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No.

SENATOR KOCH: I hope not.

SENATOR MURPHY: I will withdraw that amendment for the moment, Mr. Speaker.
