SPEAKER MARVEL: This is the last amendment, Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I withdraw it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If no objections, so ordered. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker and members of the body. I want you to know I respect Senator Murphy's amendments and I have no ill feelings. I am certain that he is generally in favor of community improvement financing and there are some things that obviously have bothered him a little bit about the bill but I would remind the body that this piece of legislation is not unique to Nebraska but generally it is the same type of legislation that those many other states have with as regards to community improvement financing. In fact, it is basically taken from other states and their statutes. I would ask this body to accept the amendments and the committee amendments as amended and that LB 158 as amended be advanced to E & R Initial. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is that the bill be advanced to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? We are voting on advancement of LB 158. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of LB 158 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, reluctantly I ask for a record of the vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Do you have something to read in?

CLERK: Yes, sir, Mr. President, LR 77. Read. (See page 1860, Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, that will be referred to the Executive Board.
