SPEAKER MARVEL: Next order of business, item #6, Select File. I wonder if I could talk to Senator Hoagland and Senator Cullan for just a moment. First of all, I recognize Senator Wesely on the E & R amendments to LB 172.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 172.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted. Now I have an order of business here but we also need to determine the status of amendments that have been introduced. So, Mr. Clerk, why don't we start with the business on your desk and then we will go to the others.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment I have is offered was Senator Marsh and that is on page 1511 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I ask unanimous consent to withdraw the motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any objection? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is offered by Senator Haberman. I have a note that that will be withdrawn. In fact I have two amendments from Senator Haberman both of which are noted as being withdrawn.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any objection to the withdrawal of the two amendments from Senator Haberman? If not, so ordered. Next.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a series of amendments from Senator Cullan and I have a note that those are to be withdrawn.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Cullan. Do you ask unanimous consent to withdraw your amendment?

SENATOR CULLAN: Yes, Mr. President, I ask that all or any amendments I have pending with the exception of those co-signed be withdrawn.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All right, next group.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp has two amendments
