SENATOR NEWELL: How many are excused, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: At the moment, there are two, four, six, eight, nine.

SENATOR NEWELL: Nine, that should be at least forty. I think there is three more people that we can bring in.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Landis, will you record your presence please? Senator Chambers and Senator Lewis are the only ones not present.

SENATOR NEWELL: Will the Sergeant at Arms see if Senator Chambers is in his office? He never answers his phone. I think if you could knock on the door it would be more successful.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote commenced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me. The Clerk cannot hear the votes. Will the legislators please take their seats? Okay, continue.

CLERK: Roll call vote continued. (See page 1873, Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner, do you wish to advance the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 591 be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to advance the bill to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. I guess you will have to clear the Board first. Voting to advance LB 591 to E & R for engrossment. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. Bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 582.

CLERK: I have nothing on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, are you ready to advance the bill? Motion is to advance LB 582 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Say
