SENATOR NICHOL: We are voting to suspend the rules. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting aye.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Stoney, we need 30 votes the Clerk says. Have you all voted please? Have you all voted? Senator Stoney, I voted so you actually have 28.

SENATOR STONEY: Is everyone present?

SENATOR NICHOL: Please vote. Senator Chambers, do you wish to be recognized?

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to suspend the rules and take up the resolution, Mr. President.

SENATOR NICHOL: The rules are suspended. Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President, I wish to thank the members of the body. I don't wish to prolong this. I move the adoption of the resolution. Thank you.

SENATOR NICHOL: We are voting on the resolution of Senator Stoney's. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting aye.

SENATOR NICHOL: We will need 25 votes on this please. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the resolution, Mr. President.
