SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to go back to it?

SENATOR NICHOL: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Do we have amendments to the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, sir, we do. There are E & R amendments to LB 368, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol, do you want to move the adoption of the E & R amendments?

SENATOR NICHOL: Yes, I will move for the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 368 (sic).

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is for the adoption of the E & R amendments on 378. All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Nichol.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Venditte had amendments pending but I have a note from him that he wishes to withdraw those amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the unanimous request to withdraw the Venditte amendments, is that the issue?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, so ordered.

CLERK: Senator Hoagland now has two sets of amendments. The first are on page 1635.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I would move to withdraw those amendments, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Hearing no objection, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hoagland has amendments on the Journal page 1824.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker, colleagues, when this bill was up for debate about three weeks ago why I indicated I would contact some attorneys in Omaha and seek their assistance in rewriting the provisions. We brought that rewrite back. That draft was criticized by attorneys that
